Congratulations with your new Hama Beads Lacing Set!

Create your own patterns or follow the instructions either on the packaging or in Hama Inspiration Book 4 (available separately).

See accompanying Diagrams as you follow these instructions:

- Thread an even number of beads. These beads become rows 1 and 2.
 You have now the desired width of your pattern. Remember to tie a knot on the first bead.
- Row 3: Thread one bead and draw the thread through the second bead. Thread one more bead and draw the thread through the fourth bead. Continue across the row. The zigzag pattern is beginning to show.
- 3. Row 4 and the following rows: Thread one bead and draw the thread through the last bead from the previous row. Keep on adding beads and draw the thread through the beads from the previous row.
- Continue to bead row by row until you get your desired length.
 Fasten the last bead.

If the thread gets too short simply tie it together with a new length of thread. You can also use elastic thread if you want to use your pattern for example as a bracelet.
